Camp Great Rock, located in Buckeystown, Maryland, offers children and teens with epilepsy (ages 7-16) seven days and six nights of summer fun

and adventure, while providing them with personal attention and medical supervision that guarantees parents' peace of mind. Sponsored by Children's National Medical Center, Camp Great Rock strives to enhance the child's self-esteem, confidence and independence by encouraging social connections, challenging activities, team building skills, and fun. Children learn more about their abilities in a safe, supportive and highly interactive environment.

PROGRAM

Camper participants and choose from activities including team sports, swimming, fishing, arts and crafts, a low and high ropes confidence course, hiking, writing workshops, camp Olympics, self defense, and yoga. Support groups and educational programs promote knowledge, skill development and social connections. Children and teens gain a better understanding of their condition, strengths, and self-worth. Campers meet many kids with epilepsy and learn a lot about themselves. All activities encourage connecting with others to create lifelong friendships and memories.

STAFF

Camp Great Rock is staffed 24 hours a day by neurologists and nurses from the Department of Neurology at Children's National Medical Center. Trained camp counselors are selected for their genuine interest in the care of children and teens. Many counselors are college students and professionals with epilepsy. Campers benefit from their experience, knowledge and understanding. Staff members receive specialized training which includes specific instructions in seizure recognition, first-aid, and the special needs of children with epilepsy. Each child receives personal attention and medical supervision. There is an arrangement with local hospitals and medical centers in case of an emergency.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

For \$750, children experience a week-long overnight camp filled with great activities, friendships and fun. The residential dorm offers comfortable, spacious rooms and baths. Payment plans and a limited number of scholarships, are available to eligible campers. Camp Great Rock will make a strong effort to accommodate any child with epilepsy who wants to attend.

Complete the registration form on the reverse side. Submit the form to the Department of Neurology, Children's National Medical Center with your non-refundable registration fee. You will receive an application package in the mail. If your child is new, an interview will be scheduled.

COST

The cost is \$750.00 per camper, which includes the \$150.00 registration fee.
