June 29 – July 5, 2019



- Camp Take Hold is a 7-day/6-night camp for 9-18-year-olds diagnosed with cerebral palsy
- Leadership training program is offered for counselors-in-training, ages 16-18
- Campers learn about their condition from medical experts providing 24/7 medical supervision
- Support groups address issues particular to children with cerebral palsy and those relevant to all children
- Through induced restraint by on-site PTs and OTs, campers are encouraged to use their involved side
- A support network of peers who share the condition is created
- Campers participate in a wide range of fun and challenging activities:
