- Camp Take Charge is a 6-day/5-night camp for 9 – 17-year-olds diagnosed with T1D
- Leadership training program is offered for counselors-in-training, ages 16-17
- Campers learn about diabetes from medical experts who provide full time medical supervision at camp
- Support groups address issues particular to children with diabetes and those relevant to all children
- Campers learn to regulate their food intake, exercise, and insulin as it relates to their diabetes
- A support network of peers who share the condition is created
