- Camp New Friends is a seven-day, six-night camp for 7-17 year olds diagnosed with NF.
- Leadership training program is offered for counselors-in-training, ages 16-17.
- Camp Next Step is offered for young adults with NF, ages 17-24, July 11-15
- Campers learn about NF from medical experts who provide full time medical supervision at camp.
- Support groups address issues particular to children with NF and those relevant to all children.
- Camp New Friends reduces the social stigma and feelings of isolation associated with NF.
- A support network of peers who share the condition is created.
- Campers participate in a wide range of fun and challenging activities:
